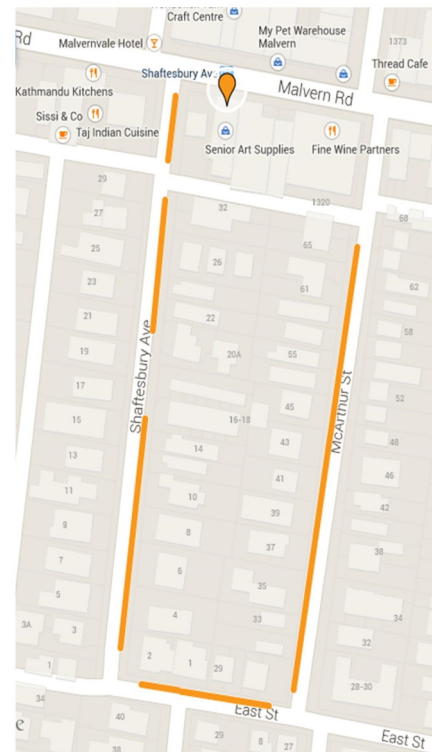
Paints:

Parking:

Brushes:

Please bring the best you have or can afford.

Preferable big round mop and round pointed brushes, squirrel and or sable. (NOT SYNTHETIC!).

Suggested: Alvaro's own signature range made of premium squirrel fibres, the Neef 117 series. Sizes range from; # 10, # 6, # 4, # 2, # 0, and # 00.

1 rigger or needle point brush for fine detail or lines. Suggested: Alvaro's 4400 series Size # 8.

Small synthetic brushes (970 series) for fine detail work or Alvaro's Escoda set.

Paper:

For these workshops, it is best to use from ¼ to ½ sheet sizes. You can paint larger if you choose. Alvaro will be demonstrating on ½ sheet sizes.

Additional items:

Towel, sponge, tissue, water container, 24mm masking tape, 2B-6B pencils, charcoal stick, water spray bottle, Hair dryer, painting board. *And a good sense of humour!!!*
